### Administrative Settlement Agreement and Covenant Not to Sue

EPA, DOJ, and EGLE with Crown Enterprises and MSC Land Company clarifying Environmental Liability

- •Demolish 45 structures.
- •Remove asbestos, wastes and PCBs prior to demolition.
- •Install a fence around the property.
- •Remove contaminated water and sludges from 23 pits, basements and lagoons
- •Investigate five areas for PCBs.
- •Assess and report on options for stormwater management.

MSC did additional work not required by the agreement using the same workplans.
