Soil and Groundwater Sampling

- Extensive surface soil, subsurface soil and groundwater sampling event from mid July to early Sept.
- Planning is largely set, but still ongoing as some information lags to come in.
- Many existing MW likely able to be used, which would extend our Year 1 network.
- Field adjustments will be made.
- UAS will be utilized for survey ahead of sampling event.
- There will be subsequent events.
- Share planned new MW Figure.

Sediment and Surface Water – Trenton Channel

- Planned in conjunction with additional EPA Detroit River work (Amber Falkner of EPA, Sam Noffke of EGLE).
- Planned start date August 21, should be done by Sept 1.
- Includes sediment cores, pore water, sediment traps and surface water from the McLouth site.
