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Timeline: High pH Water

<u>February 2023</u>: EGLE received citizen notification of construction in NW corner of site

March 2023:

- EGLE Materials Management Division (MMD) and Water Resources Division joint site visit (3/8/23)
- MMD site visit and sampling event (3/15/23)
- MMD follow up sampling event Creek (3/29/23)
- <u>Response actions</u>: EGLE required RTRR to prevent access and prevent migration into road (Fence and berm completed 3/24/23)

<u>April 2023</u>: EGLE and RTRR worked to establish continuous camera monitoring of the creek for visual impact

Ongoing daily observations do not show impact in creek





Timeline

<u>May 2023</u>:

- Daily monitoring of Creek
- EGLE formally notified RTRR that the NW area of the site is a "New Area of Interest" under the 2018 Corrective Action Consent Order and an Interim Measures Workplan is due within 60 days (5/2/23)
- CAG Meeting: Community raises concerns regarding human exposure risks and process for response actions (5/11/23) - (pH trigger point)

<u>June 2023:</u>

- EGLE engaged MDHHS to discuss evaluation of human health risk; MDHHS set meeting with EGLE and local health department
- Numerous media, legislative and citizen inquiries
- Construction moved into W. Jefferson (6/15/23*)
- RTRR submitted Interim Response Work Plan (6/29/23)







Timeline

<u>July 2023</u>:

- RTRR continued construction and dewatering to prevent offsite flow
- EGLE, MDHHS and Wayne County Dept of Health, Human and Veterans Services meet to discuss appropriate measures to protect public. (7/12/23)
 - During construction should monitor pH and migration from area in real time.
 - Discussed with RTRR and learned construction was nearly complete (estimated to be finished by 7/18/23)
- EGLE met with CAG leadership board (7/18/23)
 - Discussed content for September CAG meeting, commitment to update
- Response coordination and communication approach between EGLE, LHD and DHHS agreed upon (7/20/23)
 - If pH >12.5 EGLE will require RTRR to manage as a hazardous waste
 - If pH > 10 and leaving or likely to leave site, EGLE will notify LHD
- CAG member site drive by (7/21/23) –photos shared with EGLE
- EGLE approval of Interim Response Work Plan with modifications (7/28/23) – Revised plan due 8/16/2023









Timeline

<u>August 2023</u>:

- EGLE observations (8/2/23)
- RTRR submits revised Interim Measures
 Work Plan that addresses modifications
 required in EGLE review letter (8/16/23)
- EGLE observations (8/17/23) high pH water north of W. Jefferson
 - EGLE notified RTRR; RTRR not certain its from their property but willing to help address concerns
- EGLE notified LHD (8/17/23)– determination to place signage north of road – to be completed by Wayne Co Roads Dept
- EGLE observations (8/30/23)
- EGLE requested RTRR to pump onsite to influence water observed north of road



September – End of 2023

- EGLE Approval of Revised Interim Measures Workplan
- Implementation of Workplan
- Investigation Report Late Fall
- Other construction activities in immediate area
 - Fiber Optic Line directional drilling current
 - Railroad line work current
 - Gas line replacement within next year
 - Jefferson Avenue Bridge Replacement within next year
- Negotiation of new Corrective Action Consent Order to address remaining work
- Update Memorandum of Understanding between EPA and EGLE Oonagh McKenna
