### Revised Interim Measures Work Plan Approval Letter

The letter was sent to RTRR on October 24, 2023.

**Conditions of Approval** 

Surface water will be collected in Frac Tanks as needed and the fence will remain until the Revised IM Work Plan is implemented and the required Investigation Report has been approved.

If necessary, RTRR will dig below the surface onsite and pump groundwater to prevent flow offsite under West Jefferson through the railroad ballast.

RTRR must demonstrate that impacted groundwater is not migrating offsite under West Jefferson in the Investigation Report.




## Signs

 MDHHS referred EGLE to Wayne County Public Health division for guidance regarding public notification.

The County Health Division coordinated with the County Roads Division and ultimately the Wayne County Department of Public Services Environmental Services Division to oversee design and placement of signs.

Wayne County Environmental Services
Division developed signs for placement near
the tracks and Monguagon Creek, if necessary.





#### Area Inspection

- EGLE staff conducted an inspection on November 1st.
- No pooling was observed north of West Jefferson.
- Pooling water was observed in the pit area on the track behind the fence on RTRR's property. (seen on next slide)
